## Blue Cross of Northeastern Pennsylvania: “Making Better Health Easier”

\$1.90 a month. That’s all it cost a family to obtain medical insurance in 1939, when Blue Cross of Northeastern Pennsylvania (BCNEPA) was formed.

Today BCNEPA serves 550,000 individuals and companies across a 13-county region. Its cutting-edge programs include a health maintenance organization (HMO) plan, a preferred provider organization (PPO), and the Traditional Blue Cross/Blue Shield plan option for coverage by any physician virtually anywhere. BCNEPA is a member of the Blue Cross and Blue Shield Association, whose 42 companies provide health insurance to one in four Americans.

### Real-Time Data for Real-World Benefits

BCNEPA’s legacy mainframe application suffered from old age. Ed Donnelly, manager of cost accounting and financial systems, led a team to find a replacement PC-based client/server system. “We saw Sage MAS 500 ERP at a trade show,” he says, “and were excited with its real-time information management capabilities. Also, it was consistent with our SQL database requirements.”

### Complete Historical Data With Sage MAS 500

BCNEPA currently manages its core financials, as well as those of nine separate subsidiaries, on Sage MAS 500. “We get great value from the General Ledger module,” says Donnelly. “It allows us to post all financial transactions in great detail, and then store the data without archiving. We now have five years of information on our current server, so we don’t have to open a box or unzip a file. And the system isn’t maxed out yet.”

This comprehensive data bank allows BCNEPA to check the details of any activity contributing to an account balance and compare it to recent history. The system can handle up to 250 character descriptions, permitting easily understood comments. “Let’s say I notice that a department’s expenses are high compared to previous months,” Donnelly says. “I can research the accounts activity and find an explanation. This is a great analytical tool for confirming that transactions are posted properly, for reviewing historical trends and for explaining variances. It also allows us to provide more efficient support to our external auditors, saving us both time and audit fees.”
